Jesus said of John the Baptist that he was the greatest prophet that ever lived, yet in the end he suffered the same fate as many other of Israel's prophets, being killed at the hands of ungodly people. John did not strive to build up himself and his witness, rather he said that he must decrease in order that Jesus might increase. So, too, when we consider our personal witness, we need to be cautious as to whether we are giving testimony to ourselves or to the Lord. We are sinful people who live in forgiveness of sins and God's grace. Win-Some Witnesses personally testify so that through Y'shua all might be saved.

Win-Some Witness 101 Pointer

When we begin our witness, keep in clear focus who we are telling others about; it should be Y'shua! This releases us from thinking that we have to earn the right to speak or liveperfectly. Only Y'shua lived a perfect life. Let's proclaim Him boldly!!



Keeping Faithful Watch

Watchmen stood on the walls around the cities to warn the inhabitants of coming danger. One of the worst violations of the watchman's duty was to fall asleep while on watch. Next would come the failure to fulfill one's duty by not warning the townspeople of the danger coming. Win-some witnesses are people who are diligent in fulfilling our duty to warn people. The message is not a pleasant one: death is a consequence of sin, but the eternal dangers are even far greater. Only believers have this message! With love and genuine care for those who are lost, Win-Some Witnesses are watchmen for the souls of those whom God has given us to bring a witness.

Win-Some Witness 101 Pointer

The message of sin and it's eternal consequences, while not pleasant nor even popular, is nevertheless the key warning we need to sound for others. People are dying in their sin and need to hear of God's grace before it is too late. Help people to discover the consequences of sin and God's gracious provision through Y'shua.

When God began His work of creation, He called it good. When sin entered the world, it was changed. Yet God's creation still declares His Glory. While some in our communities would want a witness stopped because they don't understand it, or they disagree with the message, "Shout it from the roof tops" we are told. When we count the blessings God has given us, isn't that, indeed, cause to give praise to God? Win-some Witnesses will give praise to God, even in a joyful or loud voice.

Win-Some Witness 101 Pointer

You can tell others of the great things God has done for you or even the small things He has done for you in a great way. You have forgiveness of sin, answered prayer, healing, protection, personal salvation, and even your daily provisions about which to speak. Think about your life and all God has done for you and tell the story before you start hearing rocks speak.



A few years ago our five children finally got one of their wishes: to have a pet. Her name is Collie Flower. Have you ever tried to train a pet to respond to your directions? It doesn't happen overnight! But over time and with the proper motivation, even Collie has learned to sit, stay, come, and not chew up the shoes strewn over the floor by inattention of family members. When the Lord asks us to obey, we can choose to learn quickly, or squander our time and have to repeat the lessons He wants us to learn. God's call for us to be His witnesses has never fallen into the "optional" category. We should see that witnessing is mandated by God and our privilege to do it. Win-Some Witnesses are quick to be obedient to the will of God.

Win-Some Witness 101 Pointer

Don't resist or ignore God's call to witness, but joyfully seek opportunities to obey His command. Life is much better with Him in charge! Look intentionally to witness to at least one person each day.

If you were called into a court of law to give testimony in a trial, you would be asked to either swear or affirm that your testimony would be the truth, the whole truth and nothing but the truth. Going all the way back to the Ten Commandments, we are told not to bear false witness. When it comes to telling what God has done for our life, it is essential that we simply stick to the facts and not seek to embellish or expand on the truth. People can spot what is phony, and we should be very careful to simply present our life in a frank way, with simple reference to the past without going into unwholesome details. Yet it is important to share that we sometimes struggle in our faith, also. The old hymn said, "I once was lost, but now I am found, was blind but now I see" still carries great meaning today. Win-Some Witnesses may have had doubts about their faith in the past, but express them honestly so that others may relate, too.

Win-Some Witness 101 Pointer

Think through your personal testimony so that you can share it from memory in five minutes. You never know when you may be called upon to tell what God has done in your life. You can then be "instant in season or out of season" with your testimony to others.

Alan Rither witnessed to me for over two years before I confessed Y'shua as my Lord and Savior. He spoke many words to me, but what first got my attention was the way his face radiated the love of the Lord. He had a personal encounter with Jesus, and that radically changed his life. He had lived a so-called religious life for many years, but he was just going through the motions. Then God broke through and that light so captured my attention that I wanted to give the Gospel a further hearing. In fact, I wanted what he had in his life.

When he first told me it was because of Jesus, I rebuffed his witness. Eventually I realized that God was using him to reflect what He wanted to give to me personally. Win-Some Witnesses keep their lives polished so they can reflect the Light of the World, Y'shua!

Win-Some Witness 101 Pointer

The moon has no light of its own to shine directly, rather it reflects the light of the sun. So too, we have no light of our own, but we should reflect the light of God's Son!


Personal application of this scripture to my witness:

It would be impossible to know of God's existence but for the fact that He has reveals Himself in His Word and deeds. Israel saw the thunder on Mt. Sinai, the pillar of smoke by day and fire by night, the Red Sea part; they knew these were not accomplished by some foreign god. Elijah looked for God in all the wrong places and ultimately found Him in the still small voice; that equipped him to stand against the prophets of Baal in mighty victory. Today there is a plethora of foreign gods and goddesses: people are bowing at the altar of money, position or power, not to mention the lure of the New Age movement. Win-Some Witnesses boldly and lovingly declare that the Living God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob is the ONLY one who can save us.

Win-Some Witness 101 Pointer

One of the best modern-day resources for demonstrating the existence of God is Josh McDowell's book, *Evidence That Demands a Verdict*. If you do not have this book in your library, add it! It has a wealth of information to help you declare that God does exist.





Don't Worry, Witness!

I am sending you out like sheep among wolves. Therefore be as shrewd as snakes and as innocent as doves. "Be on your guard against men; they will hand you over to the local councils and flog you in their synagogues. On My account you will be brought before governors and kings as witnesses to them and to the gentiles. But when they arrest you, do not worry about what to say or how to say it. 

I don't know how orators did it a hundred years ago without voice amplification. When I first began public speaking, I relied heavily on the lavaliere microphone. Can you remember the ones that hung on a string around your neck and were tethered to the sound system? While they gave me the freedom to roam, I still had to be conscious of the cord, and I recall several embarrassing moments when I stepped on the cord and it thunked to the ground. Now we have wireless microphones and I am grateful for the technology. All the sound system does is amplify my voice. It generally does not have a voice of its own, except the occasional squeal of feedback. So we, too, should think of our witness not just as our words, but of God's words that are Spirit-given. Win-Some Witnesses rely on God's Spirit for the right words at the right time!

Win-Some Witness 101 Pointer

We need not worry about what we shall say, even under stressful situations. Rather the God of Shalom (peace) will give us the peace and presence of mind to speak what needs to be said.

Resurrection from the dead is not just a New Testament doctrine: God, through the prophets of old, worked to bring the dead back to life; Israel is portrayed as dry bones that will be brought back to life; Jesus, when he raised Lazarus from the dead, demonstrated that contrary to Jewish tradition, God could overcome death. Why did Jesus wait until the fourth day to go see Lazarus? Jewish tradition maintained that the deceased person's spirit hovered nearby the body for three days and then left. Even in the time of Jesus, resurrection was denied. If this were in our day, CNN would have been right on the spot with eye-witness reports. While there was no video, His resurrection remains just as much a fact today. Win-Some Witnesses speak not only of Jesus' resurrection, but of ours, too: some to everlasting life, and others to everlasting shame and contempt (Daniel 12:2).

Win-Some Witness 101 Pointer

We need to be frank today in an age of spiritual uncertainty. Y'shua was raised from the dead according to the scriptures and He overcame sin, the sting of death. We have great news to tell others. Now that's a fact!



All the Prophets Testify of Him

He was not seen by all the people, but by witnesses whom God had already chosen—by us who ate and drank with Him after He rose from the dead. He commanded us to preach to the people and to testify that He is the One whom God appointed as Judge of the living and the dead. All the prophets testify about Him that everyone who believes in Him receives forgiveness of sins through His name."

All the prophets testified of the coming Messiah. This is one way that God revealed His ultimate plan for salvation.

Starting in Genesis, God proclaimed One who would come to crush the head of the evil one; He would be a descendant of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob; He would be born in Bethlehem of a virgin; He would suffer and die becoming our sinbearer, but He would rise from the dead, conquering the power of sin! All this was spoken before it happened so that when the real Messiah came, those who had an ear to hear would listen. Win-Some Witnesses distinguish between the false voice of people claiming to be the Messiah and cling to the one True Anointed One of Israel.

Win-Some Witness 101 Pointer

It is important that we can clearly show the Messianic prophecies to honest inquirers so that they might ask God to show them if they are true. We, then, need to grow in our ability to handle the scriptures and present Messianic prophecies.



Gentiles Believing in Jesus, too??

"As I began to speak, the Holy Spirit came on them as He had come on us at the beginning. Then I remembered what the Lord had said: 'John baptized with water, but you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit.' So if God gave them the same gift as He gave us who believed in the Lord Messiah Y'shua, who was I to think that I could oppose God?" When they heard this, they had no further objections and praised God, saying, "So then, God has granted even the gentiles repentance unto life."

Did you know that the first followers of Jesus were not Lutheran, Baptist or Presbyterian or even Catholic? They were all Jewish. The Gospel first came to the Jewish people because they were the 'chosen people'... chosen to do what? They were chosen to be a light to the gentiles. That means that believing Israel was called to bear testimony to the gentiles that Jesus is the only way for salvation. It took time and the leading of the Holy Spirit for the early followers to see that they had to cross cultural and geographical barriers to reach others who were lost, too. And isn't it amazing that, just as in those early days people wondered as to how one might be gentile and believe in Jesus, so today, people wonder about the Jewish person who believes. This was God's original plan: salvation would come first to Israel and then to the nations. Win-Some Witnesses prayerfully cross cultural barriers to tell all people of Y'shua.

Win-Some Witness 101 Pointer

Christianity is not bottled up in one culture or people group. Faith in Y'shua needs to cross as many people barriers as it can so that many might be saved. But just as gentiles did not have to become Jewish to follow the Messiah, so too, Jewish people do not have to become gentile-ish. We turn from sin and turn ,with God's help, to Y'shua for salvation.



DAY 12 The Hanukkah Question

Then came the Feast of Dedication at Jerusalem. It was winter, and Jesus was in the temple area walking in Solomon's Colonnade. The Jews gathered around him, saying, "How long will you keep us in suspense? If you are the Messiah, tell us plainly." Jesus answered, "I did tell you, but you do not believe. The miracles I do in my Father's name speak for Me, but you do not believe because you are not My sheep. My sheep listen to My voice; I know them, and they follow Me. I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; no one can snatch them out of My hand.

Jesus was pressed often by the Jewish leaders, and finally they came outright and challenged Him: "If you are the Messiah, tell us plainly." They asked Him this question at Hanukkah, the feast of Dedication. [By the way, this is the only mention of this festival in the whole Bible.] The Hanukkah question, is not being asked by most Jewish people today. They have concluded without even looking at the evidence that Jesus is not the Messiah. Let me say it again, this is without looking at the evidence. Most people today have not rejected Jesus; they have never honestly considered Him. Win-Some Witnesses are willing to help people investigate the real case for the messiahship of Y'shua.

Win-Some Witness 101 Pointer

Most people today are Biblically illiterate. Jewish people and gentiles need to consider what is in God's Word before they can confess Jesus. Ask your unsaved friends if they would be willing to give you their opinion of the Book of Matthew and lend them a copy of an easy- to- read version.



Speak Forthrightly


When we communicate in America, there is a premium in being politically correct, especially in our litigious age. People choose to parse even the most commonly understood words, while others use non-descriptive describers to talk about situations when they don't wish to reveal their true feelings. When it comes to bringing the message of salvation to stubborn, lost people, we have to venture out into uncomfortable waters and trust, just as did people of old, that God would give the right words and timing. This means that we can, and should, be lovingly frank and direct in our communications. At the same time we realize that people do what they want to do. Those who want to listen will listen, those who don't, won't. Win-Some Witnesses speak frankly and directly about God's love through Y'shua.

Win-Some Witness 101 Pointer

Paul's words in Romans are a most appropriate model for our witnessing: I am not ashamed of the Gospel of Christ, for this is God's power for salvation for all who will believe. To the Jew first, and also to the Greek.



We each like to be praised for things we do. Our children crave encouragement and praise for theie achievements and accomplishments. Does it seem strange, then, to give praise to God Who has created heaven and earth? Does it seem fanatical to thank God for what He has given us, such as a victory at a sporting event, a goal reached, or even for the beauty of the day? We should praise God for all things and in the midst of all things, since He is Lord and in control of everything. Giving praise to God is but another way to bring a witness, pointing out what He has done. Unbelievers may try to squelch your witness and praise-giving. Win-Some Witnesses joyfully thank God for all He has done and is doing without concern for how others may perceive them.

Win-Some Witness 101 Pointer

When unbelievers see you giving thanks to God in good times and in times of trouble, they can see that you lean upon the grace of God in all things. People are fanatical in cheering on a sporting hero or team, so why not be fanatical about what God has done and give Him glory?





There's Comfort in Telling That Sin Has Been Paid For!

Comfort, comfort My people, says your God.
Speak tenderly to Jerusalem, and proclaim to her that her hard service has been completed, that her sin has been paid for, that she has received from the LORD's hand double for all her sins.

I have been confronted by Christians who have told me that witnessing to Jewish people is offensive. They say that we are not to be an offense, but to bring comfort. In light of the Holocaust, the Crusades, etc. we have to "earn the right to witness by doing all the good we can." Speaking tenderly and giving comfort is viewed from the physical realm. But God, through Isaiah, was offering true comfort through the payment of the penalty of sin. This is the ultimate, true comfort! Win-Some Witnesses offer genuine comfort through telling people that the penalty for their sins have been paid for through the Messiah, Y'shua.

Win-Some Witness 101 Pointer

The unbeliever will have diffuculty relating to what it is like being forgiven for sin. Try to relate your experiences in which you were under conviction because of wrong-doing. Share your release and joy of being forgiven in Christ.



Don't Omit Anything

"This is what the LORD says: Stand in the courtyard of the LORD's house and speak to all the people of the towns of Judah who come to worship in the house of the LORD. Tell them everything I command you; do not omit a word. Perhaps they will listen and each will turn from his evil way. In our modern age of instant communications, we are continuously bombarded by a barrage of sound-bite messages.

They are accompanied by an ever increasing display of visual presentations enhanced by computers to create seemingly impossible scenes. Still, we have lost much of what previous generations had, such as a well developed literary background through study and memorization. This is especially true when it comes to remembering Biblical material, since far too many people today are Biblically illiterate. We have been handed a tool through the ages to help us remember what we ought to say to those who don't know of God: the historic Apostles' Creed recounts in short order the triune God and His work of redemption through Y'shua. There is your outline for an effective witness. Win-Some Witnesses don't have to reinvent the wheel, they can use the tools already present.

Win-Some Witness 101 Pointer

Study carefully the Apostles' Creed and use it as the core of your witness. This is an excellent tool to serve in your sharing of faith.



DAY 17 God's Word Will Not Return Empty



Have you attended dreary worship services or had a sense of repetitive moroseness because, as my father used to say, "People enjoy their misery." This is how some people approach witnessing, like it is a gloomy chore, something they prefer not to do. Yet the Lord promises us that His Word will not return empty. Therefore with joy and gladness we can go out with such glorious imagery as the trees of the field clapping their hands, cheering us on. The next time you see tree limbs blowing in the wind, think of it as encouragement from the Lord; His Word will go forth and we don't have to be dourful but joyful. Win-Some Witnesses know God's word accomplishes God's plan, so rejoice already!

Win-Some Witness 101 Pointer

The best strategy for witnessing is to get the Word of the Lord into the hands of people who do not know Y'shua yet. This is to be done with joy knowing that God will use it to accomplish His purpose. "Faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the Word of the Lord." (Romans 10:17)

Win-Some witnesses are willing to intercede and risk loss - loss of friendship, loss of relationships, even loss of personal freedoms to the end that others might know gain in Messiah.

Win-Some Witness 101 Pointer

A broken heart for the lost enables us to keep close to God, knowing that His heart is also broken over those who are perishing outside of Messiah. We do not boast, but with humility approach the Throne of Grace and intercede on behalf of those who are lost.



Witnessing is Never in Vain

Therefore, my dear brothers, stand firm.

This verse is my "life-verse". By that I mean that as I look over my life as a believer in Jesus, this verse is what I cling to as I reach out as a witness for the Lord. The earlier part of chapter fifteen speaks of the resurrection hope we have. Because of that hope, we have encouragement to stand firm, resist moving backward, always pressing forward, knowing that this labor is not in vain. There are times when we will never see the fruit of our witnessing. Some plant, others water, but God gives the increase. So when doubters question why you would even try to bring the Gospel to others, disregard their attempts to take the joy of witnessing from you. Your labor is not in vain. It bears repeating, Win-Some Witnesses know that their witnessing is not in vain!

Win-Some Witness 101 Pointer

Even when you do not see the results of your witness, keep on witnessing. The results are ultimately up to God; the telling is up to us! Be encouraged, and know that your witness has great value!

Christians of good conscience hold differing positions when it comes to eschatology, or things pertaining to the end times. Some have even used the evangelization of the Jewish people and hastening their return to the Land of Israel as cause to increase witnessing. When people ask me my view, I usually respond, "Let's say that the return of the Lord is imminent, even right around the corner, then we need to be urgent in presenting the Gospel to those who are lost before He returns.

But on the other hand, let's say that His return is another 2,000 years away. Well, we still need to be urgent in proclaiming the Gospel because people are dying and there is no second chance. We need to reach them before it is too late."

Win-Some Witnesses keep in mind the return of the Lord and the shortness of life, and therefore seek to witness to all they can before it is too late.

Win-Some Witness 101 Pointer

We are promised God's power and told to go to the ends of the earth to bring the Gospel to others. Trust His power and seek the place in which and the people to whom He would have you bring the message of salvation.



Even If Family Rejects You, Witness!

But before all this, they will lay hands on you and persecute you. They will deliver you to synagogues and prisons, and you will be brought before kings and governors, and all on account of My name. This will result in your being witnesses to them. But make up your mind not to worry beforehand how you will defend yourselves. 

One of the most fascinating scenarios of Jesus resurrected life is the story of the two He met on the way to Emmaus (Luke 24:17-29). These unnamed Jewish men were discussing the topic of the hour, the resurrection. Jesus comes alongside and, by recounting Israel's history and demonstrating what the Law and the Prophets spoke of, expounds all of what God 's plan intended in the first place. We can look to the Jewish festivals and the Messianic pictures clearly shown in the Old Testament and fulfilled in the New Testament to help undergird the case of the Messiahship of Jesus. In order to do that, we ourselves need to be more knowledgeable of those things in the Scriptures so that we can accurately communicate them. Win-Some Witnesses are life-long students of the Bible so that they might better know God and make Him known.

Win-Some Witness 101 Pointer

There are great lessons in the Scriptures, especially in the Old Testament. Let's not forsake the foundation of our New Testament faith. We need to see the integrity, or wholeness of all the Scriptures so that we can retell the wonderful acts of God in human history.



DAY 23 I Once Was Blind, But Now I See

"About noon as I came near Damascus, suddenly a bright light from heaven flashed around me. I fell to the ground and heard a voice say to me, 'Saul! Saul! Why do you persecute Me?" Can you remember a time when you were not a believer in Jesus? For the first 23 years of my life I was in spiritual darkness. Then, through the prayerful witness of one caring Lutheran man, I confessed Jesus as my Messiah. I stepped from darkness into the light. I was spiritually blind, but now I see. You do not need to have the dramatic blindness-to-light conversion experience Paul had in order to know the benefits of being in the Light of the Lord. Whether you grew up in a Christian home or came to faith as an adult, the key to your witness is in your personal encounter with Jesus. If you are daily walking close with Him, then you can walk in His light and witness to all of what you have see and heard from God in your life. Win-Some Witnesses see clearly what God is doing in their life and tell others about it.

Win-Some Witness 101 Pointer

If God could use an opponent of the Gospel, one steeped in the Law and Jewish tradition such as Paul, certainly he can use willing people like us to reach those who are still in blindness.



Choose Someone to Witness with You

Therefore it is necessary to choose one of the men who have been with us the whole time the Lord Jesus went in and out among us, beginning from John's baptism to the time when Jesus was taken up from us. For one of these must become a witness with us of His resurrection."

We know that Jesus sent out witnesses two by two. This is a good principle, since you then have the opportunity to double the prayerfulness of your witness, double the know-how in witnessing and encourage each other along the way. Witnessing can lead to discouragement if you do not see results. We know the results are up to God, but still we like to see fruit. If you go it alone, you might easily become discouraged from continuing. Having someone with you will help you to remain accountable for your witness; you wouldn't want to let that person down, nor they, you. While we do not have eye-witnesses to the resurrection today, we do have life-witnesses to the power of that resurrection hope. Win-Some Witnesses look for partners in ministry so that they might urge each other forward.

Our society pushes hard on individualism. Resist that temptation to go it alone and find a partner in ministry to serve with you in your witness.

Fix your eyes? We go to the optometrist to have our eyes checked and one test he performs is for glaucoma. It used to be that the optometrist would have you look at a point of light and then they would shoot a puff of air into the eyeball. I knew it was coming and I hated it. Now, they place a few drops of a mild anesthetic in the eye so feeling is lost. Then he places a blue bulb right on the pupil to take the measurement. I am told to keep looking right into the light in order for the test to be effective. That takes real concentration, for my initial impulse is to turn away. So, too, it is with our life and witness. Our sin-filled human nature pushes us to turn away from the things of God. But others have endured before us and so we, too, are called to shake off those things which hinder us and look clearly at Y'shua. Win-Some Witnesses fix their eyes on Jesus and do not lose heart.

Win-Some Witness 101 Pointer

We are not alone in our witness; we are surrounded by a great cloud of witnesses. Read Hebrews 11 and see the many who have preceded us, then take encouragement to witness without giving up.



You Have God's Authority to Witness!

Then the eleven disciples went to Galilee, to the mountain where Jesus had told them to go. When they saw Him, they worshiped Him; but some doubted. Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to Me. Doubt!...one of the biggest blocks witnesses need to overcome.

Doubt that God is at work in our witness; doubt that we can be effective; doubt that anyone will take notice of what we are saying. Doubt is a killer. Once it takes root, confidence is diminished and the net effect is that our witness is either halted or it is slowed tremendously. God is not the author of doubt, but the giver of the authority to boldly go where men have gone before, but perhaps without bringing a witness to those they encountered. We must watch out for doubting what God can do through us. Too much time has already been lost in our lives. Take the authority given to witness and make disciples along the way. Win-Some Witnesses rely on God's authority and go while the going is good!

Some worshiped Jesus and some doubted Jesus. If you have doubts, before you start your witness, come to the point where you are a worshipper.

Then you can move ahead in the authority of God.

The new Boeing 757 aircraft has such a sophisticated computer system in it that, in theory, the computer can actually guide the plane from takeoff until landing. And, at times as I fly to different cities, I actually wonder who is flying the plane, the pilot or a computer. The door is closed, there is no real way of knowing, and yet I still get on airplanes and ride them to my next destination. I take it by faith that the pilot is sober and vigilant, and that the aircraft mechanics are good at their jobs of maintaining the critical components, for, in reality, my life is in their hands. I rest easier trusting that I will arrive safely at my destination. So, too, is our walk of faith with the Lord; we may not see Him, but we know He is with us. He will never forsake us. Win-Some Witnesses are blessed: they have not seen the Lord face to face, yet they believe.

Win-Some Witness 101 Pointer

Jesus said it clearly to doubting Thomas, "Stop doubting and believe!" To be effective witnesses we must do the same. Pray that the Lord will help us not only to believe, but transform our unbelief to strong belief!





Witness to Everyone

Then Peter began to speak: "I now realize how true it is that God does not show favoritism but accepts men from every nation who fear Him and do what is right. You know the message God sent to the people of Israel, telling the good news of peace through Messiah Y'shua, Who is Lord of all. Personal application of this scripture to my witness:

Pride and Prejudice! No, not the novel; they are the sins which beset us and block our witness. I had spoken in a church on the east coast of Florida three times in a six year period. Each time the congregation dwindled in attendance. Finally, after the third time there, I had a conversation with the pastor about his ministry. He lamented to me that he had hoped there would be enough people in the church to sustain his ministry until he retired. Too many people were leaving the church because the neighborhood was changing. It saddened me to see that the pastor defined his ministry as being only to those who were already part of the church and not as reaching those who were from a different culture. They needed to hear of Jesus, too. Win-Some Witnesses overcome their pride and prejudices, and reach those God has brought near to them.

Win-Some Witness 101 Pointer

God does not show favoritism! We are all sinful human beings in need of His grace. My father-in-law once told me that all people are basically the same: they all put their pants on one leg at a time. Without pride or prejudice, let's tell whoever we can of the love of the Lord!

A Light For the Gentiles, The Glory of Israel

Now there was a man in Jerusalem called Simeon, who was righteous and devout. He was waiting for the consolation of Israel, and the Holy Spirit was upon him. It had been revealed to him by the Holy Spirit that he would not die before he had seen the Lord's Messiah. Moved by the Spirit, he went into the temple courts. 

I once had lunch with a couple who were expecting their first baby. This was not as joyful an occasion as others had experienced, for in the past year she had two miscarriages and lost both children at about ten weeks. A sister-in-law also lost a child who was still-born, and a brother a few weeks earlier had lost their 10 days old son to severe heart malformation. They were genuinely anxious to have a child and it was quite understandable for them to voice concern so that others would pray for a safe pregnancy and healthy child. But even if they have a healthy child in the flesh, that child will be born spiritually dead. We all are born dead inside because of sin. Sin is in our nature, even as King David lamented that he was sinful from the womb. Win-Some Witnesses know that there are not multiple paths to God, but only one - through the One who is the Way and the Truth and the Life (John 14:6).

Do not believe those who say that there are two ways to God, one for the Jews through their covenants and another for the gentiles through Jesus. There is only one way, through Jesus, the Messiah! (Isaiah 49: 1-6)
